**RANKING POINTS - Selection will be through a ranking by points of qualified applicants.**

**Documentation is required.**

**Points=pts.**

EDUCATION: High School diploma 5-pts. ; GED 3-pts.; HS Transcripts of courses that require following written directions to complete project (drafting, blueprint reading, pattern making, design etc.) 1-pts. per semester, maximum of 10-pts.;

WORK EXPERIENCE: construction related work experience 2-pts. per 1,000 hrs, 10-pts. Max., industry related work experience 5-pts. per 1,000 hrs, 10-pts. Max.; military experience with honorable discharge 2-pts. per year 10-pts. Max.; general work experience 1-pt per 1000 hours, 10 pts Max.

APPRENTICESHIP PREPARATORY PROGRAM completion i.e Oregon Trades Women, Job Corp or equivalent 10-pts.

DRIVERS LICENSE (valid): 3-pts.

**Description of Work**

Painters do not strictly apply paint to uncomplicated surfaces. Preparation of surfaces is one of the most important parts of painting. Surfaces may include wood, metal, masonry, etc. Besides paint other types of wall coverings may be applied such as vinyl, fabric and metal surfacing materials. Decorative applications of paint and innovative designs are also part of the job description.

**RELATED TRAINING**

A minimum of 144 hours of related training is currently required each year.

**WAGE SCHEDULE**

The average wage for those journeymen employed by the participating employer in the occupation is \$20.70 effective April 1, 2015. The progressive wage rate to be paid the apprentice is:
